Indications: Treatment of allergic reactions, nasal allergies, and hives.

## **Table Notes:**

AGE LIMITS: Avoid diphenhydramine under 2 years of age unless instructed by healthcare provider.

**DOSAGE:** Determine by finding child's weight in the top row of the dosage table **MEASURING the DOSAGE:** Syringes and droppers are more accurate than teaspoons. If possible, use syringe or dropper that comes with the medication and measure in mL. **FREQUENCY:** Repeat every 6 hours as needed **ADULT DOSAGE:** 50 mg

**RISK of SIDE EFFECTS:** May cause drowsiness and paradoxical excitatory. Use caution when driving or operating heavy machinery after dosing due to potential for sedation and decreased alertness. This is especially relevant for teen drivers.
